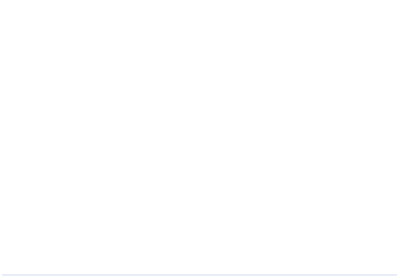
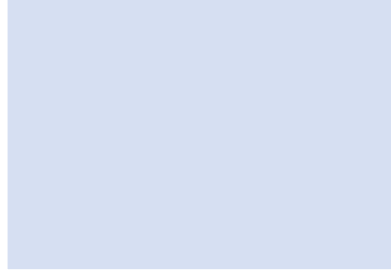


Our Mission

The Art in All of Us (AiA) mission is to inspire children across borders to build a tolerant world for tomorrow. We hope to develop creativity, curiosity and the artistic sensitivities of children in the 192 UN-listed countries by providing them the opportunity to discover the world of poetry, drawing and photography. By giving them a voice, children are empowered to express their feelings, build their self-esteem, and create a more positive future.

Our vision is to educate with Art, and promote multicultural understanding across boundaries, through exchanges, and partnerships, while inspiring Global Citizenship. With Art as their tool, children, and in turn, adults will be able to gain knowledge of cultural similarities and differences, and to embrace the "unknown" with tolerance, understanding and curiosity.

Our Core Programs

AiA Pen Pal Program: This cornerstone initiative promotes artistic communication between children of different countries. Through the help of an AiA ambassador each student will then begin exchanging his creations with a child living in another country, in doing so we take the first step towards becoming a more peaceful and understanding community.

AiA World Art Book Program: The World Art Book will showcase each and every one of the schools AiA have visited in 192 UN-listed countries. The Book is a portfolio of the children's vision of their own country. Each country is represented by a portrait of a resident, drawings and poetry created by a local child.

AiA Awareness Program: The Awareness program introduces drawing, poetry, and photography to schools whilst promoting multicultural exchanges through interactive art activities. We work with the 8 - 12 age group by guiding, teaching, and helping them understand different cultures through exploring their differences and similarities. Playing games, singing songs, and of course drawing and crafting priceless works immerse the children in the fascinating world of culture and communication.

Curriculum Development Program: The Art in All of Us Curriculum Kits introduce students to the countries and cultures of the world, using our extensive database of children's artworks showcasing over 15,000 drawings and poems. The AiA Curriculum Program is about children teaching other children through the use of their own creativity. Their knowledge is richly enhanced by understanding cultural differences and connecting globally.

Our Achievements

Art in All of Us has reached over 11,000 children in 175 countries around the world.

We have set up programs in 250 schools, taken 160,000 pictures and inspired the creation of 13,000 pieces of art.

We have recruited 130 volunteers from 31 countries across the globe and are currently expanding our team to include over 150 people!

AiA at a glance

What is Art in All of Us? Art in All of Us is a not-for-profit organization that works with children from around the globe promoting cultural tolerance through artistic communication. It was founded in 2005 by photographers Anthony Asael and Stephanie Rabemiarafara from a shared love of art, children, and culture. AiA is created around the simple premise of Art as a universal language.

Who do we work with? AiA works with children from the 8 - 12 age group, opening their eyes to new cultures and new ideas.

Who are the AiA photographers? The founders, Anthony and Stephanie, are the primary photographers. AiA showcases their travels through their photographs, children's poetry, and drawings which are exhibited throughout the world.

How is AiA funded? Art in All of Us is funded via private donations and partnerships. It is a 501(c)3 organization and has the backing of UNICEF in New York City since 2005.
